Send the following things to rader@unbc.ca with "lab applicant" in the subject line:

Everyone (including Summer Research Fellows)

- 1. A cover letter describing who you are, what your long-term interests are (research, medicine, fishing...), what lab experience you have, and why you are interested in the Rader lab in particular
- 1. Your transcript (an unofficial version is fine)
- 1. Contact information for three references who know you personally in a research or academic context

Independent Study (Chem 499) students

- 4. Your proposed course schedule
- 5. Any other significant time commitments you may have

Graduate Students

- 4. Your CV
- 5. Reprints of any publications you may have and a description of your contribution to them
- 6. A one-page description of a question that interests you in pre-mRNA splicing and how you might go about addressing it
- 7. A list of funding agencies that you can apply to for graduate fellowships or bursaries

Postdoctoral Fellows

- 4. Your CV
- 5. Reprints of your publications and a description of your contribution to them
- 6. A five-page research proposal on a question in pre-mRNA splicing
- 7. A list of postdoctoral fellowships to which you can apply
