Problem

Code solutions to problems P2.15 *p.* 76 (the standard color names in a GUI), P2.16 *p.* 76 (two solid squares), and P3.21 *p.* 123 (Olympic rings).

- Your program should be contained in a package `cpSC101.yourname.lab4` where *yourname* is your unbc userid, and *q* is the number of the lab assignment that you are handing in.

- You should create a `.jar` file that contains both your `.java` and your `.class` files.
