# Laboratory Assignment Computer Science 101—Winter 2016

## **Externally Suspended Warriorhood**

### **Purpose**

To practise manipulating Strings, Files and logic.

#### **Due Date**

The completed lab assignment is due Friday, 2017-01-20 by the beginning of lecture.

#### "Unnullified" words

Some words — for instance, "externally" and "suspended" — contain six or more consonants, all in *non*-increasing order. For the purposes of this lab assignment, consonants are letters that are neither vowels, nor 'y'. A vowel is any one of 'a', 'e', 'i', 'o', or 'u'. Note that a consonant may appear more than once, but the sequence of consonants cannot contain an increasing pair. For instance, "extranatally" is illegal because 'n' comes before 't'.

⇒ Search the file /usr/share/dict/words to find all of the words that it contains that have the above property. Write the list of words to a file tesserarian.txt in your lab directory, and print the file when you hand in your assignment.

Regardless of where or how you develop your code, transfer it to a lab machine in 8-457 and run it there.

Think very hard about the required logic, and code as cleanly as you can.
