For the purposes of this lab assignment, consonants are letters that are neither vowels, nor ' y '. A vowel is any one of 'a', 'e', 'i', 'o', or 'u'.
$\Rightarrow$ Search the the file /usr/share/dict/words ${ }^{1}$ to find all of the words that it contains that have the above property. Write the list of words to a file constitutive.txt in your lab6 package directory.
Think very hard about the required logic, and code as cleanly as you can.
